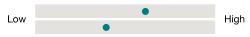

Investment management style

The strategy is built through 100% bottom-up stock analysis, with macroeconomic factors only being considered in order to determine their impact on individual companies as part of the bottom-up research. The Global equity team is focused on stock selection and identifying high quality companies that generate consistent and strong return on invested capital as well as a superior growth. Close to 100% of the portfolio's decisions are therefore attributed to bottom-up analysis and the portfolio is only impacted by risk guidelines dictating exposures to countries and sectors. The fundamentally-driven investment process focuses on bottom-up company research. The investment process consists of the following 4 steps: (1) Idea Generation (2) Fundamental Analysis (3) Portfolio Construction and (4) Risk Management. The team manages a relatively concentrated portfolio of 35-45 securities.

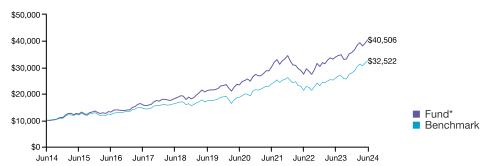
